We are excited to have your sailor with us, whether returning to continue building on their skills, or just starting their journey. The next two weeks will be filled with lots of on the water skill building as well as fun games and activities designed to enhance your child's sailing learning.

You will be receiving several important papers in the next few days. Please ensure you go over the code of conduct with your sailor, sign it, and return it on the first day of your session. Plan to join us for the banquet, where your sailor's progress towards achieving their level is celebrated both formally and with a "fun" award. Returning your banquet form indicating your potluck contribution will help us plan food accordingly.

To make each day run smoothly and safely, please ensure your child:

- Arrives at 9 am and is picked up by 4 pm, and brings the following:
 - A brightly coloured Coast Guard certified life with WHISTLE attached.
 - A bathing suit and towel (preferably worn to camp to speed up getting on the water).
 - Arrives wearing sunscreen and bring extra so they can reapply as necessary.
 - A hat and sunglasses (you may wish to put a floatie on the glasses, as students do often end up in the water).
 - A clearly marked lunch bag. In an effort to keep the wasps at bay, all garbage will be sent home.
 - Closed toed shoes (to be worn at all times).
 - An extra set of clothing (including warm layers).
 - Lots of drinking water.
